PRECAUTIONS FOR USE




Gloves: When handling larger quantities:

Respirator: Type AX-P Filter of sufficient capacity. (AS/NZS 1716 & 1715, EN 143:2000 & 149:2001, ANSI Z88 or national equivalent)

Storage and Transportation: Store in cool, dry, protected area. Use only in well ventilated areas. Take precautionary measures against static discharges. Dispose of this material and its container at hazardous or special waste collection point. Keep out of reach of children. Keep container in a well ventilated place. Keep away from heat. Keep away from sources of ignition. No smoking.

Fire/Explosion Hazard: HIGHLY FLAMMABLE. Vapours/gas heavier than air. Toxic smoke/fumes in a fire. Risk of explosion if heated under confinement. Use only in well ventilated areas. EMERGENCY



FIRST AID

Swallowed:	Do NOT give milk or oil. Do NOT give alcohol.
Skin:	Wash with soap & water. Apply cleansing cream.
Advice To Doctor:	Emesis generally unnecessary. Debride for subcutaneous injection. Evaluate for respiratory distress. Consider lavage with cuffed tube. NO adrenalin.
Fire Fighting:	Keep containers cool. Foam.
Spills and Disposal:	Eliminate ignition sources. Absorb with dry agent. Stop leak if safe to do so. Use only in well ventilated areas. Take precautionary measures against static discharges. Dispose of this material and its container at hazardous or special waste collection point. This material and its container must be disposed of in a safe way.
